

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I join a team?

We have a club structure in place. You can contact the clubs directly or contact CSBA for assistance.

Alternatively, your school can enter a team as a 'club'. We have a variety of school teams who play in our competitions.

What is a club?

A club shall consist of any organisation which enters one (1) or more teams into a competition run by CSBA.

What age group am I eligible for?

U10s – cannot be turning 10 this year

U12s – cannot be turning 12 this year

U14s – cannot be turning 14 this year

U16s – cannot be turning 16 this year

U18s – cannot be turning 18 this year

We have separate boys and girls competitions.

When are games?

Friday night in Alexandria – Under 16 and Under 18 boys and girls

Saturdays in Alexandria – Under 10, 12 and 14 boys and girls

Saturday afternoons in Marrickville – Under 16 and Under 18 boys

Where are the games played?

Friday nights: U16s and U18s girls – Comets Stadium and Perry Park Recreation Centre, Alexandria

Saturdays: U10s – U14s boys and girls – Comets Stadium and Perry Park Recreation Centre, Alexandria

Saturday afternoons: U16s and U18s boys – Marrickville PCYC

What are the costs involved?

Registration: is a 12 month insurance membership fee that is **compulsory** to be paid before players take the court in any CSBA competition

Current registration fees (2020):

- Under 10/12: \$87

- Under 14/16/18: \$112

Game fees/club fees: game fees vary from club to club, depending on training costs, game fees, uniform fees, etc. These are paid directly to your club and team organiser.

How long is each competition?

We run three (3) competitions per calendar year. For an indication of dates:

- **Comp 1:** February – May
- **Comp 2:** May – September
- **Comp 3:** September – December

Competitions are usually around 9-11 weeks in length, plus semi-finals and grand finals

When do fixtures (draws) come out?

Fixtures will be released in the week leading up to the first round. Please note: fixtures may change if teams pull out or move divisions.

Do we need uniforms?

Your club/team organiser is in charge of organising uniforms for your team. All players must be in the same uniform with numbers clearly on the front and back of the singlet.
